Branches Continuing to Serve Hundreds of Federal Workers in Need Affected by Government Shutdown

January 29, 2019 – Branches has been extremely busy serving hundreds of federal workers in Miami who have been affected by the Government Shutdown. Almost two weeks ago, Branches' Financial Wellness team served at the Miami International Airport, providing information about critical financial resources to TSA employees. Last week, Branches served alongside Feeding South Florida at their distributions and once again provided resources and information about assistance for government employees.

Branches has been helping individuals with financial coaching, free tax prep, helping navigate late mortgage payments to banks, utility companies etc. and with the support of United Way of Miami-Dade, is providing rental and utility payment assistance for those most in need. Branches is actively looking to secure funding to also help affected workers with transportation and childcare costs. Even though the Shutdown has officially ended, thousands of federal employees are still waiting to be paid, and many federal contractors, unlike other government employees, are not expected to get back pay for the paychecks they missed during the 35-day shutdown.
