From the Desk of the Director

Spring 2017

Opportunity = From YET to YES!

Dear Friends,

At Branches we create opportunities for students and families to succeed in school and in life. But what exactly do we mean? Here is an example from our work with youth; over the years we have observed that far too many Branches students have become stuck at an early age in their general outlook. They aspire less, settle for being average, avoid significant challenge and ignore useful feedback among other things.

As we form long-term relationships with the children, we have often learned the root causes of this mindset. For example, did you ever struggle with an academic subject when you were a student? Did someone step in and help you learn?

For myself, I struggled with writing in elementary school. Soon however my Mom would proofread my writing homework. With her support, I would revise and improve every assignment before I turned it in. Who knew I would major in English Literature in college?! In contrast, so many of our Branches students also struggled early in a particular academic area but never got the support they needed to overcome the challenges. For many of their families, education has never been a priority or something within their reach. The sad result is that the student begins to believe they are unable to learn and are limited in what they can achieve.

To confront this obstacle, we developed Climb program workshops to engage the youth on what it takes to cultivate a growth mindset – passion and perseverance. One of the exercises asked the students to identify a subject that they have not 'YET' learned. One student identified math. As a result, we began intensive 3x per week tutoring with her to learn math. From the first session, the volunteer tutor realized that she needed to learn the most fundamental math subjects such as addition, subtraction and multiplication. She was very eager to learn and advanced quickly. After six weeks and a particularly difficult 'pop quiz', she burst out of the tutoring room exclaiming that she had just scored a 100% on

the quiz. She saw Kim Torres, Director of Student Services, and said 'YET!' proudly displaying the 100% result. Kim responded with 'YES you can!' and gave her a hug.

As we create learning and growth opportunities for students and families, we fulfill what it means to be part of the Branches family. It takes so many of us – staff, volunteers, donors, partners, churches – to make Branches what it is today. It is a place of opportunity where students and families are both challenged and supported to grow in their outlook from YET to YES! Thank YOU for being part of the Branches family!

Growing Young Minds

In partnership with families and schools, the Branches Grow program serves over 200 elementary students by cultivating a love of learning and a spirit of compassion. When Valentin joined Branches Florida City during the 2014-2015 school year as a Kindergartener, he had extreme difficulties remembering letters, basic sounds, and sight words. We provided Valentin with one-on-one tutoring and helped him to enroll in a special remediation program for struggling students in his school. Despite these interventions, Valentin needed to be held back in 1st grade.

After two more years of working with and nurturing Valentin through loving, personal support, he is exhibiting an accelerated rate of academic and personal growth this school year. In addition to reading much better, he enjoys being a leader and helping younger students in his group. Reinforcing Valentin's enthusiasm to lead, AmeriCorps members Michael and Ray offer him responsibilities that he relishes and finds relevant. As a result, his confidence has soared and his ability to focus, recall knowledge, and exhibit self-control has greatly

improved. After being told that a parent conference was requested, Valentin's mom was apprehensive. Imagine her surprise to hear about her son's ability to read, learn, grow, and lead! The transformative power of care, concern, and love defines the uplifting atmosphere found at Branches. By providing meaningful opportunities, Branches enables children like Valentin to expand their horizons and experience success.
