Branches' 20th Annual Thanksgiving to Deliver nearly 5,000 Meals to Families in Need

On November 26th, 2020, Thanksgiving morning, Branches plans to cook, package and deliver nearly 5,000 hot meals to needy individuals and families from 6 different sites throughout Miami-Dade and Broward counties. This is the largest meal delivery effort in Florida on Thanksgiving Day. Just a few hundred volunteers will give of their time on Thanksgiving morning by putting together individual meals via assembly lines and passing them off to volunteer drivers who deliver them. Branches had to extremely limit the number of volunteers this year in order to ensure all COVID-19 safety precautions are being followed, however meals will still be provided as they are needed this year more than ever before. Each meal includes turkey, green beans donated by Goya Foods of Florida, stuffing, mashed potatoes, cranberry sauce, a bread roll and of course a piece of pumpkin pie.

However, Branches' Thanksgiving Meal Delivery is about much more than just a hot meal; all meals include a Meal Insert in English, Spanish and Creole which provides meal recipients with valuable information about free community resources and programs provided by Branches and other key partners. Thank you to United Way of Miami-Dade for printing those full-color Meal Inserts.

Branches is grateful to be celebrating its 20th Thanksgiving Anniversary. Branches partners with several local United Methodist Churches and congregations to make this Thanksgiving miracle possible. Volunteers begin the cooking preparations a few days prior to Thanksgiving which include the seasoning of turkeys and prepping of all the sides and dessert. Many volunteer chefs and cooks will spend countless hours getting ready for the big day to make sure that everything goes off without a hitch. This year, Sushi Maki has also been hired to provide some traditional Thanksgiving meals since volunteer help had to be limited due to COVID-19.

In addition, Branches will provide over 400 hot meals to its Grow & Climb children and youth program participants on Thanksgiving Eve, which includes a wonderful celebration focused on gratefulness.
