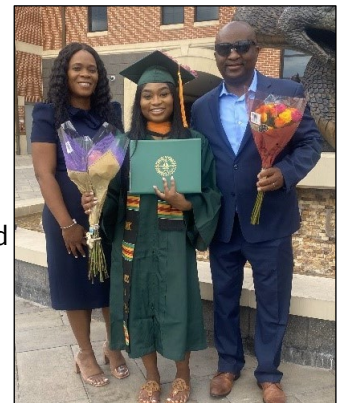
A Message from the CEO

Supporting Youth, Supporting Families

At Branches, we provide life-changing opportunities for hardworking families and their children. That's what we always say. But what does that mean? It means we provide services and programming which are two-generational and transformational, not transactional. We believe all people are creative, resourceful and whole and with the right opportunities are empowered to fulfill their dreams and goals.

We just celebrated 75 graduations over the last few months from Kindergartners to 5th graders to High School seniors and college graduates! These milestones hold so much meaning for our students and their families as together they experience personal and academic growth and success.

For example, one of our recent college graduates, Vicky, grew up at Branches and enrolled in Miami-Dade College in 2019. Her first year of college coincided with COVID-19 creating challenges that Vicky overcame especially with the support of Branches. We provided quiet space, internet, supplies, and food for our students so they could attend online classes. Perhaps more importantly, we provided students including Vicky with a community of support to ensure they could persist through a very challenging time.



Vicky's next goal was to apply to Florida A&M University's nursing program. Branches team works with students and their families to complete the FAFSA application, create a budget and apply for scholarships including the Branches' Climb Higher Scholarship. When she arrived on campus in 2021, she had the built in support of other Branches students already attending FAMU. Just a few months ago, Vicky graduated from the nursing school at FAMU and in June she became a registered nurse! She will be working as a postpartum nurse in Houston, TX. Her parents and the entire Branches family are so proud of Vicky and all that she has accomplished so far!

Together we are transforming lives of children and families through life-changing opportunities! I could not be more grateful for each and every one of you who support our mission, thank YOU!
