Branches to Provide Community ID's for Miami-Dade County Residents

On February 1, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved Mayor Daniella Levine Cava's plan to launch a Community ID program in Miami-Dade County.

Branches is honored to have been selected to lead this program for our community. Once the ID program is launched, residents will be able to apply for a card at a Branches site or attend an outreach event which will be held on a regular basis across the county.

The Miami Community ID will be an accepted form of photo identification for select County services that can be life-changing for many Miami-Dade residents including seniors, survivors of domestic violence, formerly incarcerated or homeless individuals, foster youth, transgender individuals, undocumented residents, and others lacking proper documentation. These residents often struggle to obtain a form of identification demonstrating that they live in the county and therefore have difficulty accessing basic services.
